ERD FOUNDATION-GUWAHATI

Education Research & Development Foundation (ERDF) is registered as a charitable trust under the provision of Indian Trust Act 1882 and as per the provisions under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860. The head office of the Foundation is located at ERDF Bhawan, Lalmati Road, Bhetapara, Guwahati. ERDF is the largest & fastest growing educational network in the north-eastern region, catering education from KG to PG to Ph.D. There are 9,000 students in the institutions of ERDF out of which 20% belong to the indigent and underprivileged. At present, ERDF institutions have 65 courses, 36 Departments and 7 Research Journals. Nearly 22,000 students have graduated from different institutions of ERDF wherein more than 17,000 alumni are settled in various sectors across the country. The BAMS courses under IA Ayurvedic College & Hospital have begun for the academic year 2023-24.

About USTM

The scope of nursing includes diverse specializations such as critical care nursing, oncology nursing, pediatric nursing, and geriatrics. Indian-trained nurses are highly sought after globally, especially in countries like the US, UK, Europe, and the Middle East, creating international employment opportunities for them. The integration of technology into nursing practice, such as telemedicine and health data management, has also expanded the field.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

A.N.M. (2 Years Course Including Six Month Internship)

Eligibility Criteria

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
2. The maximum age for admission shall be 30 years.
3. The minimum educational requirement is passing 12 years of schooling (10+2-year course) recognized by CBSE/ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination.
4. Medical Fitness: Admission is subject to a satisfactory medical examination report.

G.N.M. (3 Years Course Including Six Month Internship)

Eligibility Criteria

1. Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM:
 - a. 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible for State Open Schools recognized by the State Government and the National Institute of Open Schools (NIOS) recognized by the Central Government. However, Science is preferable.
 - b. 10+2 with English, 40% marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
 - c. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized. CBSE board/State/Centre
 - d. Registered ANM with a pass mark.

Admission Process

2. Admission of students shall be once a year.
3. Students shall be medically fit.
4. The minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as of 31st December, of that year).
(The upper age limit is 35 yrs. For ANM/ LHV, there is no age bar).



B.SC. NURSING (Eight Semester Including Six Month Internship)

The admission process for the BSc Nursing program is conducted through the Government of Meghalaya, Directorate of Health Services. Interested candidates must first complete the online application and pay the prescribed fees, and then appear for the entrance test. Based on their performance in the exam, a merit list will be published, and successful candidates will be selected for admission.

Eligibility Criteria

Age: Applicants must be between 17 and 35 years old as of December 31, 2024.

Educational Qualifications: Candidates should have passed the 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English, securing at least 45% marks in aggregate (40% for SC/ST Candidates).

Admission Process

Online Application: Complete the online application form available on the official website www.meghealth.gov.in

Application Fee: As per the Government of Meghalaya

Selection Procedure

c) Original documents, including age proof, educational certificates, and NEET-UG 2025 score card, must be presented during counselling as per the Notification.

d) Selected candidates will undergo a medical examination at their own expense.
